- _____ 6. Make your own SpiralScouts neck cord.
- _____ 7. Learn what the 5 elements mean as they relate to SpiralScouts.
- _____ 8. Hold an office for at least 2 meetings.
- _____ 9. Participate in an awards ceremonial.
- _____ 10. Learn the names of the other members of your circle or hearth.
